

Hoop the Quilters grid sticky side up
and sew out the first color
It will give the out line of the block.
and where to place the fabrics.
Using the map given you can use
a disappearing ink pen
and mark the numbers of sew out

**Place first fabric faced up and place the second fabric
(White) on top of it and sew the next color
Trim to 1/4 seam, and fold fabric over and Press**



**Place the next fabric (white) face down on the next line
Sew next color and repeat the trimming and pressing**



This is how I trim to a 1/4 seam



Fabric folded over and pressed



**Add your next fabric and continue repeating the steps. Sew ,
trim fold fabric over and press.**

**Main flower is done,
Only the 4 corners
to add and the embroidery**



**Corners done
then the last seam around the
entire block. to frame it up
then sew out the embroidery design**



Using a plastic ruler,
use the last seam out line
of the block
and cut your 1/4 inch
seam allowance
